

 - ✓ Yield submit to God, resist the Devil and he will flee



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


Do you believe YOU are worthy?

This is one question that all of us ponder at one time or another. The most important part of the question is do you truly know that you are worthy to receive all that God has for you?

One of the most potent strategies of the Enemy is deceiving us into believe that we are unworthy.







By faith, as a divine gift of God's grace, through the power of the Holy Spirit, we now have the "Righteousness of Jesus Christ" living within us. Jesus is the RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Therefore, we can say in complete confidence, "As a child of the Most High God, I am an heir of God and coheirs with Christ; therefore, I AM WORTHY! I am no longer unworthy in any way!" (Romans 8:17)

This is about knowing who we are in Jesus Christ... and taking our thoughts captive to His obedience from the Enemy's lies.





Many times I have run into individuals or heard about Christians and non-Christians – young and old, male and female, wealthy, beautiful, and talented...successful according to the world, yet; they hold **this belief of being totally unworthy.** Nothing seems to fill the void within them!

I have felt it many times myself. However, as a True Believer, we realize this notion comes **straight from the Enemy's camp**.

As long Satan has us believing we are unworthy before God and unworthy of the abundant life, then hope is squelched, and the door is wide open for his attacks.





Usually, a **door that was opened** ("the OPEN DOOR") for this deception creates footholds and continued attacks.

A few include:

- derogatory thoughts that enter our mind,
- unhealed wounds from the past,
- or the unfiltered words of others in our life.

These attacks can be destructive only if you choose to receive them as truth (through denial, deception, or lack of discernment) or decide not to accept the healing that can ONLY be found in Jesus Christ.





Characteristics of someone experiencing an overwhelming sense of unworthiness which leads to the **bondage of rejection**–

Some "RED FLAGS"

- 1. Feelings of inferiority (superiority complex)
- 2. Uncontrollable fear and anxiety
- 3. Oversensitive to the words or actions of others
- 4. A critical spirit, judgmental, cynical
- 5. Perfectionistic and/or controlling
- 6. Angry and unforgiving leading to bitterness
- 7. Hard to show love or receive love from others
- 8. Inability to maintain healthy relationships
- 9. Addictive and/or obsessive behavior
- 10. Desperate to find love at all costs
- 11. Continually in a state of depression, which leads to oppression



Possible underlying "ROOT CAUSES" of the bondages (burdens or weights):

- 1. Parental abuse
- 2. Death of a loved one
- 3. Divorce or abandonment
- 4. Living in an unhealthy abusive relationship
- 5. Hurtful event(s) perpetrated by:
 - a) spouse
 - b) relative
 - c) neighbor
 - d) teacher
 - e) friend
 - f) co-worker
 - g) and even a member of a church





So, how do we find and get THE FREEDOM?

As children of God, we have the right to a healthy emotional life, knowing that we belong, have worth, and are competent individuals. Yet in a temporal world this concept is fleeting because it is built on man's competence. Our righteousness will never measure up.

So, how do we find and get THE FREEDOM?

By God's Righteousness Through Faith – Romans 3:21-26

But now apart from the law the righteousness of God has been made known, to which the law and the Prophets testify. This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to ALL who believe.

There is no difference between Jew and Gentile, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement through the shedding of his blood—to be received by faith.







So, how do we find and get THE FREEDOM?




This passage explains the relationship between righteousness and the law and shows that it is not the law that produces righteousness, but faith in Jesus Christ.

...because those who believe can keep the righteousness of the Law through faith in Jesus Christ. No one has kept the letter of the Law except Christ....












